Your OneCommunity volunteer hours have been renewed in Paylocity!

Don't forget that all full-time employees receive 8 paid hours to volunteer. You can choose to work on an initiative as a group, or you can choose your own organizations at which to volunteer.

You can request to take a volunteer day (or half day) by selecting "VTO" in Paylocity. Volunteer hours do not roll over to the next year. Don't forget to complete the <u>volunteer form</u> when you've completed your project.

PTO PROCESS CHANGE

Effective January 1, 2024, we have changed the *process* for PTO but NOT the *amount* of PTO. Now, on the first of the year, you will receive your full allotment of paid time off to be used throughout the year.

Just like before, you must receive manager approval before taking time off, and there may be periods where you cannot take time off (i.e. boat shows, peak in-season days, etc.).

As a reminder, our PTO tiers are shown below, and the respective hours are reflected in Paylocity.

Years	PTO
90 days-2 years	10 days
3-5 years	13 days
5 years+	15 days

CENTRAL MARINE TRAINING DAY


The Central Marine team attended a training for FlustMaster this past week. FlustMaster is an automated engine flushing system that Central Marine has been offering since this past summer.

ADD A SHORTCUT TO THE BOAT SHOW LEAD APP ON YOUR PHONE

The home screen on your smartphone or tablet isn't just a place where your apps live. You can also add shortcuts to websites, including the site for boat show lead entries (http://shows.revver.com).

Here's how to create an "app" for any website on your device, allowing you to access shortcuts directly from your home screen.

iPhone or iPad

- 1. Open Safari. Other browsers, such as Chrome, won't work for this.
- 2. Navigate to the website you want to save to your home screen by entering the URL of the website you want to create a shortcut to. Make sure you visit the exact page you want to open through the shortcut. Tap "Go."
- 3. Tap the Share button on the bottom of the page. It looks like a square with an arrow pointing out of the top.
- 4. In the list of options that appear, scroll down until you see "Add to Home Screen". Tap this. The "Add to Home Screen" dialog box will appear.
- 5. Choose a name for the website shortcut on your home screen. You'll see the link so you can confirm it, as well as the site's favicon that will appear as the "app" icon on your home screen. Click "Add" when you're done. Safari will close automatically and you will be taken to where the icon is located on your iPhone's or iPad's home screen.
- 6. Now just tap the new "app" or shortcut on your home screen, and it will open the website in its own navigation window, independent of what you have open in Safari.

Note: If you ever decide you want to remove the website shortcut, you can delete it just like you would any other app on your phone.

Android

- 1. Open Chrome.
- 2. Navigate to the website or web page you want to pin to your home screen .
- 3. Tap the menu icon (3 dots in the upper right-hand corner) and tap "Add to Home Screen".
- 4. Choose a name for the website shortcut, then Chrome will add it to your home screen.
