## **Baby Boater**



#### OSHA'S HAZARD COMMUNICATION STANDARD

This Hazard Communication Standard is OSHA's "bread and butter" when it comes to fines and penalties. It is easy to correct these issues, but it takes a little effort. The primary areas of concern are the SDS books and chemical labeling.



The standard calls for us to have a SDS (Safety Data Sheet) for every chemical on site. The book must also contain a complete chemical listing and be indexed in a manner that will facilitate quick retrieval of any SDS.

The above diagram shows all the required information that needs to be on the GHS-compliant label. All the required information can be readily available on the SDS. Remember that even though WATER does not require a GHS label, the bottle must be marked as "WATER".


#### SUNRISE MARINE POPS AND PROPS EVENT


